Dear Parents and Carers

Re: Bus Service Changes

We are aware of the recent details of the further issues surrounding the ending of the 360 bus route and the deficiency of appropriate transport from the Eastern Green, Mount Nod and Bannerbrook areas to Westwood and we have been working to ensure we have appropriate, effective and viable resolutions in place to ensure pupils can more easily get to school and can also access after school activities.

We are looking to put a permanent solution in place as quickly as possible to enable children to get to and from school efficiently and safely.. This is likely to mean a chartered bus service dedicated for Westwood. This will be a paid service and again would be based on similar prices charged for public bus routes. In the meantime we will put in place a temporary minibus service.

We welcome your suggestions for alternative routes and once we have compiled details of interested pupils we can best assess a route which is mutually acceptable.
