

Pupil Saturday session: We are once again running our programme of collaborative Saturday teaching sessions in conjunction with British Mensa. These workshops, for your Gifted & Talented or your highest attaining children, have been taking place during the autumn and spring terms and will conclude in the summer term. The next workshop session will take place on Saturday 20<sup>th</sup> May 2017: 10:00 – 3:00 and is aimed at children aged 4 - 6 years.
